## Cromwell – 117<sup>th</sup> Federal Funding Snapshot

### **Topline Numbers:**

- \$5.4 million in direct American Rescue Plan Act funding
- \$1 million in Federal grant
- \$6.3 million in direct Infrastructure and Investment and Jobs Act funding

#### American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) Funding:

- The Town of Cromwell has received more than \$5.4 million in ARP funding:
  - o \$1.4 million in Local Aid
  - o \$2.6 million in County Aid
  - \$1.3 million in Educational Aid
- The Town allocated \$165,000 to premium pay for Town and Fire District employees who worked through the height of the pandemic

#### **Federal Grants:**

- \$33,000 Emergency Connectivity Fund (ECF) grant to Cromwell Public Schools to purchase laptops and internet equipment for students
- \$1 million in Restaurant Revitalization Fund (RRF) grants for 5 Cromwell restaurants:
  - \$775,000 to Torza's Professional Golf and Amusement Center, 150 Sebethe Drive
  - o \$190,000 to Café Luna, 35 Berlin Road
  - o **\$30,000** to Subway, 543 Main Street
  - o \$22,000 to Nardelli's, 136 Berlin Road
  - \$5,000 to Luen Hop Chinese Restaurant, 34 Shunpike Road

# Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA):

• **\$6.3 million** for local projects on the State Transportation Improvement Plan (STIP)
