I am requesting funding for the Van Meter Public Safety Building Project. They are requesting \$500,000 in funding.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Van Meter, located at 505 Grant Street, Van Meter, IA 50261.

The City of Van Meter is seeking funding of a new public safety facility. The facility will provide additional space for public safety equipment, training and provide needed space to provide community para-medicine programming, and a community meeting space for community events.
