- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "GI Education Benefits

6	(a) In General.—Section 3319(c) of title 38,
7	United States Code, is amended to read as follows:
8	"(c) Eligible Dependents.—
9	"(1) Transfer.—An individual approved to
10	transfer an entitlement to educational assistance
11	under this section may transfer the individual's enti-
12	tlement as follows:
13	"(A) To the individual's spouse.
14	"(B) To one or more of the individual's

22	(b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by sub-

24	ance payable under chapter 33 of title 38, United States
