On behalf of the American Physical Society (APS), the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers with its subdivision of the Nuclear and Plasma Sciences Society (IEEE/NPSS), and the organizing committees, we are pleased to announce the 21st biennial Particle Accelerator Conference, PAC05. The conference will take place from May 16-20, 2005, at the Knoxville Convention Center, Knoxville, Tennessee, USA, which is in proximity to Oak Ridge National Laboratory (ORNL) and the Spallation Neutron Source (SNS). Our late colleague, Robert S.
