

NOAA Fisheries Announces Public Hearings in California

The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's (NOAA's), National Marine Fisheries Service (NOAA Fisheries) has scheduled six public hearings in locations throughout California to gather public input on its draft hatchery listing policy and proposed Endangered Species Act (ESA) salmon listing revisions.

The hatchery policy considers the role of hatchery fish in ESA listing determinations and the updated listing proposals address the ESA status of 27 evolutionarily significant units (ESUs) of salmon and steelhead on the West Coast; including 10 that occur in California. NOAA Fisheries believes that these two proposals are closely related and important to salmon recovery. Combining opportunities for public engagement on both issues into the same public hearing is an efficient use of the agency's and the public's time

NOAA Fisheries has scheduled these hearings to allow the public the opportunity to provide comments directly to agency staff during the comment period. However, these public meetings are not the only opportunity to provide input on these issues. Additional methods to comment may be found at the end of this news release. The public and stakeholders are encouraged to continue to comment and provide input to NOAA Fisheries until the scheduled close of the comment period on October 20, 2004.

The format of the six public hearings will be traditional in nature. There will be introductory remarks regarding the hearing and a short presentation by NOAA Fisheries staff that provides and overview of the proposed hatchery listing policy and proposed listing determinations. The hearing will then be opened for the public and other interested parties to present oral comments on the two proposals. Depending on time availability, there may be a question and answer session after the conclusion of public comments. The hearing proceedings will be transcribed by a court reporter and the transcripts will become part of the administrative record for the two proposals.
