

## Who We Are

Arizona Project Safe Neighborhoods (AzPSN) is a collaboration of federal, state and local agencies that have banded together to combat firearm violence. The United States Attorney's Office for the District of Arizona and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives are the key agencies driving the program. Other partners include the offices of county attorneys, local police departments and other state and local law enforcement agencies.

Community outreach is an important function of AzPSN because the fight against gun violence will be won neighborhood by neighborhood, block by block. Arizona Firearm Safety Coalition has been designated the community outreach arm of AzPSN, and as such, the coalition is seeking the support of all Arizona citizens who want to make their neighborhood safer.
