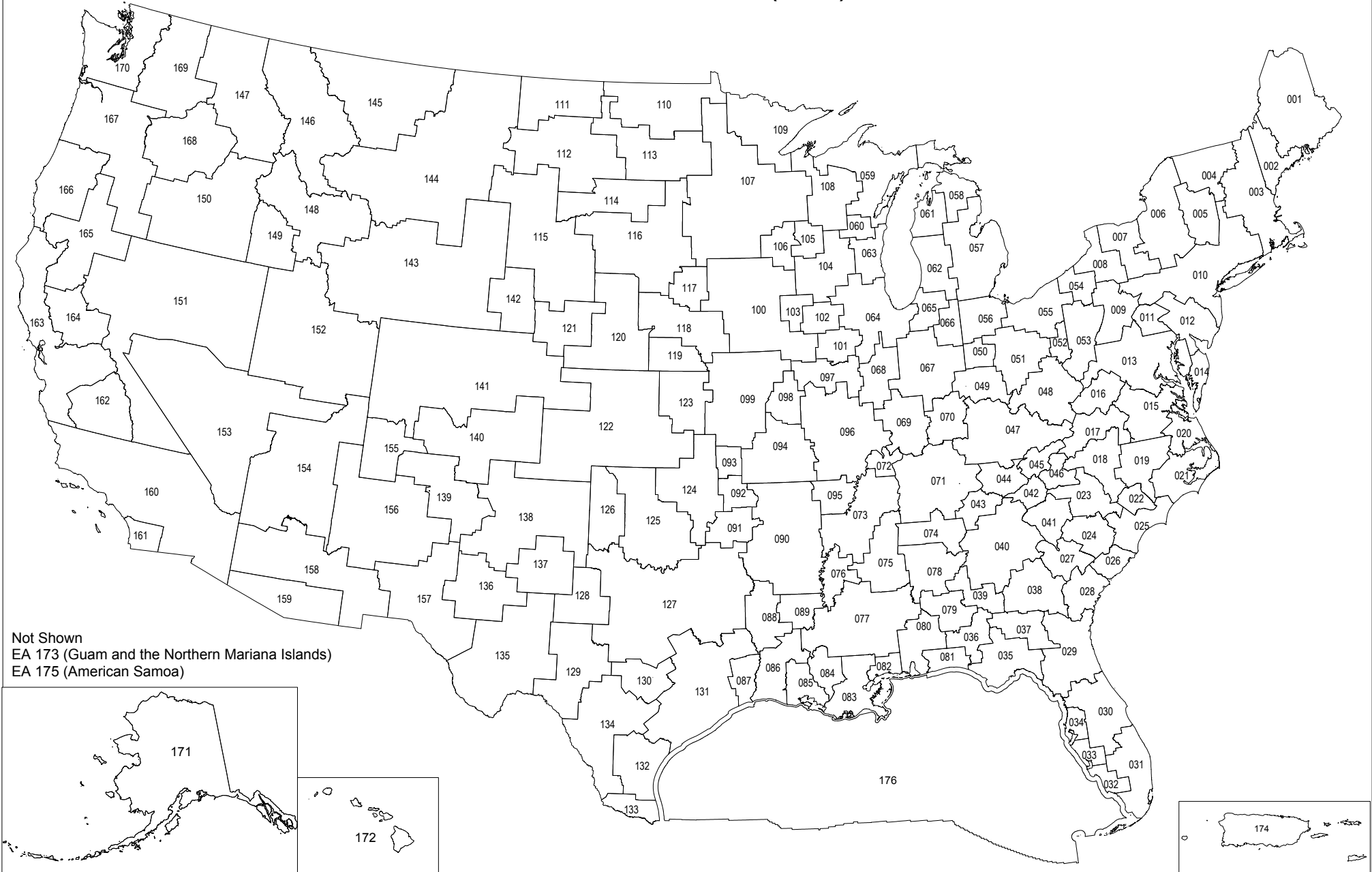


24 GHz Service Economic Areas (EAs)

Additionally, there are four FCC-created EA-like areas: (1) Guam and Northern Mariana Islands, (2) Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands, (3) American Samoa, and (4) the Gulf of Mexico, for a total of 176 EAs; see also Amendments to License Fixed Services at 24 GHz, Erratum, DA 04-1588 (rel.
