Synopsis:

Between 2:30 a.m. and 3:00 a.m., August 26, 1964, two masked males entered the residence of SAMUEL BRONFMAN at Tarrytown, New York, and at gunpoint, forced Mrs. BRONFMAN to open the small bedroom safe, and escaped with approximately \$270,000.00 in jewelry. On August 29, 1964, Buffalo Division advised that [REDACTED]

DETAILS:

This investigation is predicated on receipt of a telephone call from Tarrytown Police Department, Tarrytown, New York, on August 26, 1964, to Special Agent [REDACTED] White Plains Resident Agency, reporting that between the hours of 2:30 a.m. and 3:00 a.m. on August 26, 1964, two masked individuals entered the residence of Mr. and Mrs. SAMUEL BRONFMAN, 723 South Broadway, Tarrytown, New York, and at gunpoint, forced Mrs. BRONFMAN to open the bedroom safe. The two masked unknown subjects escaped with approximately \$270,000.00 in insured jewelry. b7c

Mr. SAMUEL BRONFMAN, President, Distillers Corporation, Seagrams Limited, whose headquarters office is in Montreal, Canada, was contacted at his New York City office located on the 5th floor of the Seagrams Building, 375 Park Avenue at 52nd Street, New York City. Mr. BRONFMAN advised that he and his wife SAIDYE BRONFMAN, reside at 15 Belvedere Road, Montreal, Canada and have a summer home located at 723 Broadway, Tarrytown, New York, where they reside for approximately 2 1/2 months during the summer of each year. He also stated that he and his wife maintain an apartment at the St. Regis Hotel, New York City for occasional use.

According to Mr. BRONFMAN, he and his wife are staying at the St. Regis hotel during the night of August 27, 1964 and will return to Montreal, August 28, 1964. Thereafter, he will visit his New York City Office every week or two. Should any further contact with him be necessary this may be arranged through his secretary Mrs. MORROW 5th Floor, Seagrams Building, New York City, telephone number 572-7000.

Mr. BRONFMAN related the following facts concerning the armed robbery perpetrated against him and his wife at their Tarrytown residence on August 26, 1964:

He and his wife retired at approximately 11:30 p.m. August 25, 1964. At approximately 2:00 a.m. they were awakened by two men, one of whom shined a flashlight in their faces. In reply to Mr. BRONFMAN's question, "What's this?" the unknown subject (Unsub) stated, "This is a stick-up. Don't be alarmed. We don't intend to hurt you, just do what you are told and you will be all right."

The man with the flashlight then ordered Mrs. BRONFMAN to open her safe. This safe, which contained her jewelry, was located in the bedroom. The man with the flashlight accompanied her at the safe while she opened it. The man with the gun, Unsub Number 1, remained with Mr. BRONFMAN and kept the gun pointed at him. Mr. BRONFMAN remained in bed.

The Unsubs succeeded in obtaining about \$200,000 worth of jewelry and some cash. Most of this was obtained from the safe, however, a few items of jewelry were obtained from a drawer in the bedroom closet. The Unsubs opened this drawer themselves.

After taking all of the above jewelry, the man with the flashlight, Unsub Number 2, asked Mrs. BRONFMAN, "Where's the rest of it?" and stated, "We know you have more, we know your house." However, Mrs. BRONFMAN convinced the Unsubs that there was no more jewelry available.

After obtaining all available jewelry, Unsub Number 2 took both Mr. and Mrs. BRONFMAN into the bathroom and tied them to the verticle section of the bathroom wash basin. Several of Mrs. BRONFMAN's stockings. They were tied with their backs to the wash basin sitting side by side on the bathroom floor. The only light used by the Unsubs during the entire robbery with the exception of the last few minutes, was that from the flashlight. However, when Mr. and Mrs. BRONFMAN were being tied in the bathroom, the bathroom light was turned on. Unsub Number 2 was in the bathroom with them but wore a sock over his face so that his features could not be observed. Unsub Number 1 remained out of sight, just outside the bathroom door.

After the BRONFMANS had been tied the Unsubs ordered them to remain quiet for 20 minutes. Unsub Number 1 told Unsub Number 2 to "Get the tools" and Mr. BRONFMAN's wife saw Unsub Number 2 pick up several tools, which the Unsubs had brought with them. The two Unsubs then bolted the bedroom door and departed by the fire escape.

Mr. BRONFMAN untied himself in about five minutes but waited for about 30 minutes and then telephoned the Estate Superintendent, Mr. NELSON, who resides in a separate cottage on the grounds of the estate. Mr. NELSON then telephoned the police in Tarrytown.

Mr. BRONFMAN stated that he is able to set the time of the holdup as between 2:00 and 2:30 a.m. August 26, 1964. He stated that while he and his wife were being tied up, the bathroom clock was knocked over and stopped at exactly 2:25 a.m. The Unsubs left about five minutes after the clock was knocked over, which would be about 2:30 a.m. He believed that their time of entry into the house was about 2:00 a.m. inasmuch as he estimated that the total time between their entry and exit was about 30 minutes.

Mr. BRONFMAN commented that the Unsubs treated him and his wife with remarkable politeness throughout the robbery. They operated in a very soft, soothing, easygoing manner and at no time used vulgar or threatening language.

Mr. BRONFMAN stated that the name of his estate at Tarrytown is Belvedere and that on several occasions during the robbery the Unsubs referred to him as Mr. BELVEDERE, apparently thinking that this was his name.

Mr. BRONFMAN further advised that he only saw one gun, which was held by Unsub Number 1 and believed that it was an automatic and not a revolver, inasmuch as "it had an angular appearance." He specifically noted that the barrel was not round but appeared to be hexangular.

Mr. BRONFMAN stated that the Unsubs apparently entered his residence by "jimmying" the window in his study, which is located on the main floor.

Mr. BRONFMAN furnished the following partial descriptions of the Unsubs and commented that due to the darkness and the fact that the Unsubs faces were covered, he could not furnish more complete descriptions.

Unsub Number 1 (man with gun)

White

Approximately 5 feet 7

Slender Build

White handkerchief over face but ruddy complexion showed over handkerchief

Possibly slightly under 30 years of age, judging by his voice

Had a nice clear voice, which was slightly high-pitched

Mr. BRONFMAN thought his voice had a "very slight Irish lilt, but not an Irish Brogue." This Unsub appeared to be nervous and on several occasions told Unsub Number 2 to hurry up. His hand which held the pistol shook slightly, apparently from tension.

Unsub Number 2 (man with flashlight)

This Unsub was two or three inches taller than Unsub Number 1, so therefore he would be approximately 5 feet 9 or 5 feet 10. He wore a sock over his face and some kind of a round white hat on his head. He was slender and judging from his voice, was about the same age as Unsub Number 1, slightly under 30 years of age. He was called "SAM" several times by Unsub Number 1, who repeatedly told him, "Hurry up, SAM." This Unsub was "cool as a cucumber" and not nervous as Unsub Number 1. Also, judging from his voice, Mr. BRONFMAN thought he was possibly white. However, Mr. BRONFMAN stated that Mrs. BRONFMAN was with Unsub Number 2 more than he, and she, judging from his voice, thought he was colored.

Mr. BRONFMAN further stated that the fact that he and his wife were preparing to leave Tarrytown and return to Montreal in the very near future was a well-known fact to his office staff.

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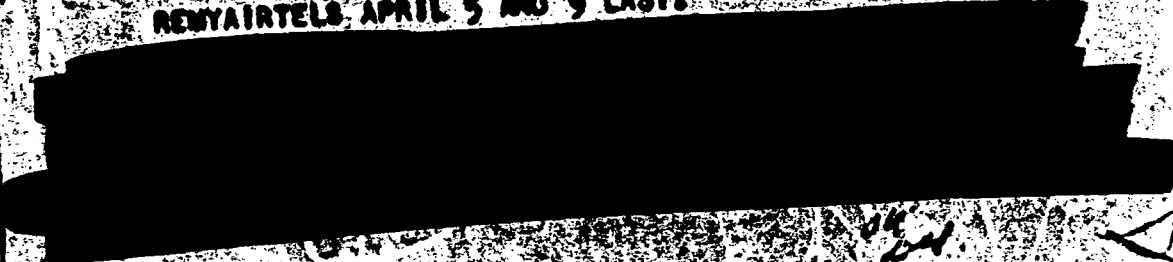
