Fulton County Medical Examiner has advised that the remains appear to be that of a young child; however, no positive identification has been made.

At approximately 1:55 pm on the same date, the body of a young black male was discovered in a ditch in DeKalb County, Georgia. This body was tentatively identified as that of Patrick Baltazar who was last seen alive 2/6/81. The DeKalb County Medical Examiner advised that the victim died of ligature strangulation and had been dead for a period of more than 72 hours.

Attached teletype from Atlanta Office concerns Atkid, Major Case No. 30, and is a summary of investigation conducted regarding the owner of [redacted] prestige license tag.

The Las Vegas Division located the individual to whom the Georgia [redacted] license tag was issued and determined that her husband threw it away sometime last Fall. Two other similar name plates were issued in Nevada but both individuals to whom plates issued washed out as subjects in this case.

The State of Rhode Island issued one [redacted] tag but investigation by Boston Office proved to be negative regarding possible involvement of owner.

No other [redacted] or similar name plates were issued in Georgia. Atlanta Office is currently reviewing a list of 45,000 Chevrolet Nova automobiles in an effort to identify the car used to kidnap [redacted]

The State of Kentucky has issued one [redacted] plate and Louisville Office is conducting the appropriate investigation to locate the person to whom the tag was issued.

A computerized query was made of all state DMVs regarding the [redacted] license plate. Thirteen states have issued [redacted] tags and leads have been set forth for appropriate investigation.

The Scientific Analysis Section has completed all analyses on items submitted to date in captioned matter. The specimens received were found as a result of a crime scene search conducted by Bureau Agents southwest of Atlanta, Georgia, on 1/10/81. They include remains of shot shells, pieces of a recording tape, pieces of cloth, loose pages of a Penthouse magazine and a cigarette butt.

Analysis has determined the shot shells to be probably in excess of 20 years old. No blood or semen was found on any of the specimens. The recording tape was determined to be the remains of a commercially produced recording of "pop" music.

The Latent Fingerprint Section of the Identification Division is processing all items for fingerprints of value.

The individual involved in the murders has very bad eyesight and wears glasses. She felt he may drive a vehicle, possibly a van, that is bright in color and the vehicle may be damaged. She feels that he is possibly white and 30 years of age or less. The subject also has a scar on his chin and is "city oriented". He has reddish brown hair and is of medium height with a muscular build. He was born during a major eclipse which would have occurred on 3/18/50, 9/12/50, 3/17/51, 9/1/51, 2/25/52, or 8/20/52. She feels that he was born on or near (within two days) 3/18/50 or 9/12/50.

He was a victim of child abuse and may have possibly been taken away from his parents during his youth. He is possibly a high school dropout and is employed in some type of manual labor, i.e. truck driver, transporting food or other food products. She feels that the first killing took place around 6/8/79, and resulted from divorce action or separation from his estranged wife. He has two children by her.

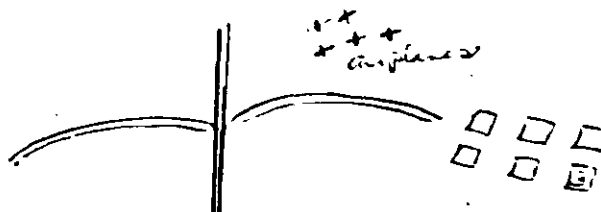
