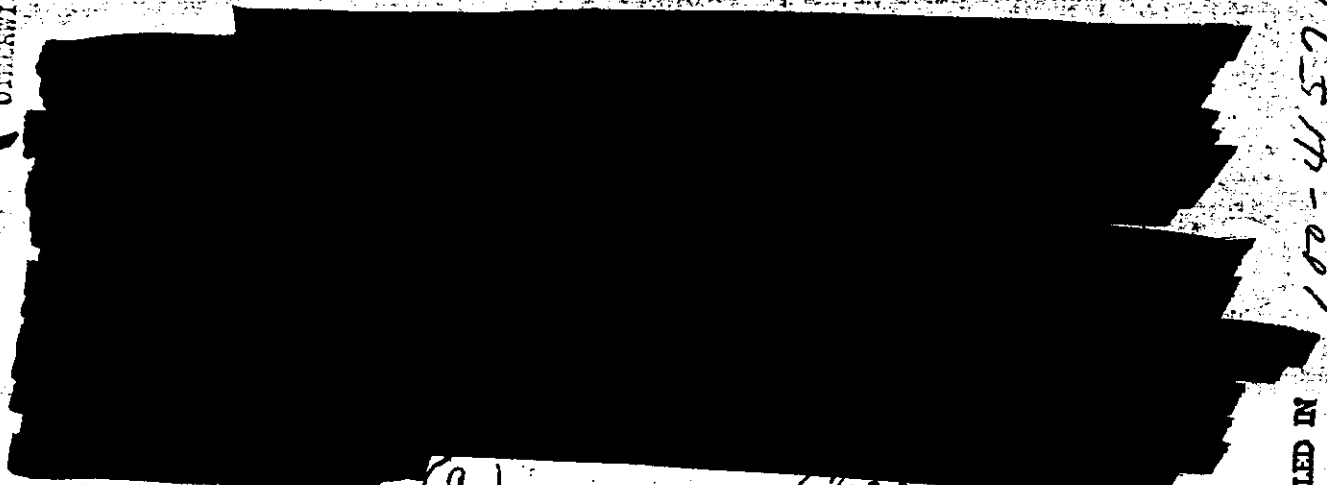

It is requested that your office furnish us an up-to-date Membership Roster of the Council on Foreign Relations.

Since 1960, data and information that we have in file has what one may call blank spots. Some of it we have not been able to correlate and properly authenticate.

We have no problems through 1958, but from 1960 to date we need your help.

Any additional information that you can furnish about the organization and their activities to date would be helpful.

It looks as though there must be as many as half a dozen government intelligence groups that are working in the same medium as this office. Our activities lie strictly in the area concerning the threat to the internal security of the State and the Republic as outlined on the back of this letter.

Lecturer Foresees 1972 Dictatorship in the U.S.

A dictatorship will be in control of the United States before the election of 1972, according to a former undercover agent for the FBI.

He spoke this week to students at Loyola-Marymount University.

David Gumaer, 30-year-old member of the John Birch Society, said the people of this country will call for such a move — and the country will be taken over without a shot being fired.

"In the spring of 1972," he told students in the student center patio, "rioting will start 'spontaneously' on the campuses and in the ghettos.

"Communications will be cut off and the stock market will go broke.

"And then the people will call for 'law and order in the streets' and marshal law will be declared ... and we will have a dictatorship."

Ruling this country will be a group of 1,450 elite called the Council of Foreign Relations (CFR), Gumaer claimed.

He bases his theory, which he insists is fact, on investigations of the CFR by another former FBI agent, Dan Smoot, and his undercover work in various left-wing student faction groups during the earlier half of this decade.

Currently he is making a tour of campuses across the nation in hopes of persuading students not to become duped into the supposed plot.

The CFR wants confrontation, he said, and is using legitimate issues like poverty and ecology to promote strife.

But the issues are being twisted, he said, so that reason is left out.

Things are building until 1972 when the dictatorship takes over, "just like Hitler ... with no shots being fired ... on the pretense of law and order."

Complete censorship will go into effect, air transportation will be controlled, long jail sen-

tences without trial will be imposed and the students and people from the ghettos will be shot in the street, he claimed.

"The CFR will have created a Frankenstein (frustrated, violent students and blacks) and must kill it before it kills the organization," he told the group.

Such dictatorial steps have already taken place in Canada, he said. Prime Minister Pierre Trudeau imposed the War Measures Act because of threats by the French separatists.

"Yet those people (separatists) were out of jail a few days later and the police state measures are still in effect ... It was just a pretense," he said.

The CFR is involved in Canada as it is in the affairs of the Soviet Union.

With headquarters in New York City, Gumaer said, major Soviet programs are cleared first through the CFR, across the street from the Russian Embassy, before implementation.

He drew a picture for the students of near-control of the United States at the present time.

With top news executives in the organization, the people of this country "are told only what the CFR wants them to know."

The CFR also is in control of the "no-win war in Vietnam" and the Paris Peace Talks which are just a charade to make people here despair, he claimed.

"We don't let our men go in and win the war," Gumaer said, "since the generals in the CFR have more to gain by dragging it on ... and letting our men die.

"Our men don't bomb Hai Phong Harbor," he claimed, "because it is full of our allies' ships along with the tankers from Standard Oil."

Nelson Rockefeller, who owns Standard, is a member of the CFR, he charged.

After telling more about business between American companies and Communist countries, he went into a long list of prominent persons who he said

belong to the 1,450-member CFR.

They included representatives from practically all fields including the military, education, law, religion, government, business and the mass media.

Some of the more famous include former Sec. of State Dean Rusk, David Rockefeller, former Sec. of Labor Willard Wirtz, Postmaster General Winton Blount, former Sec. of Defense Robert McNamara and Charles Hitch, president of the University of California.

The list also included President Richard Nixon. Students applauded as Gumaer charged the President with being an active member of the CFR until 1962. He is still controlled by the CFR, Gumaer claimed, and 100 members of his administration are CFR members.

The speaker also blamed Vice President Spiro Agnew for making the nation choose up sides — part of the confrontation plan.

The ultimate aim of the CFR, he said, is to have a one-government, socialistic world with the 1,450 members of the CFR in control and reaping the profits.

Leaving home in New York at 18, Gumaer joined Fidel Castro guerillas in 1957. He was a beatnik and marxist in Greenwich Village and participated in various left-wing radical group conferences, he said.

He says he saw what these people are really doing and discovered it was not a humanitarian cause. Continuing to work with the radical groups, he began feeding information to the FBI.

On questioning from the students, he said the FBI and some sections of the military are the only groups not fully contaminated by the powerful CFR.

Even the House Un-American Activities Committee, now called House Committee on Internal Security, is composed of two CFR members now.

He said a federal directive, signed by former President Dwight D. Eisenhower, forbids the FBI from investigating government employees.

(All Presidents since Roosevelt have been controlled by the CFR except for John Kennedy who was killed by CFR order, he said.)

He cautioned the students not to play into the CFR's policy of frustration. Investigate he CFR, he said, who are causing the problems and protest against them.

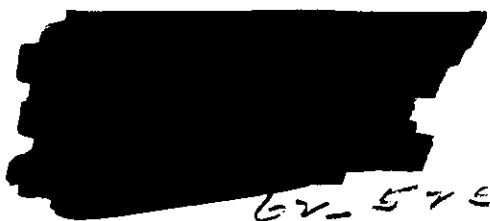

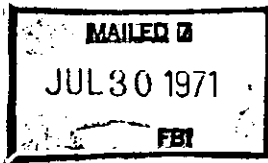

Dear Sir:

Louisiana's chief affliction, Hale Boggs, has said that you like to be remembered at Christmas and on your birthday. If you will forgive me the tardiness as well as that reference, please accept my sincere best wishes this season. It is my earnest hope that you will continue to serve many more years as Director of The Bureau.

For more than ten years I have studied such information as has been available to ordinary citizens regarding the Council on Foreign Relations. My conclusions are that this covert group is actively conspiring to usurp the Constitutional authority of the United States Government and to direct it toward its own sinister ends.

I realize this organization accumulated massive powers within our government before its conspiratorial nature became fully evident. For one branch of government to undertake to destroy this super monster is admittedly akin to demanding another David to confront Goliath. Still, if you and your bureau cannot be that David, our nation faces its greatest peril in nearly two centuries.

In 1948, Alger Hiss was protected and shielded by a massive array of powerful men, both in and out of government. Because of the perserverance and dedication applied by your bureau, he was eventually indicted and justly prosecuted. 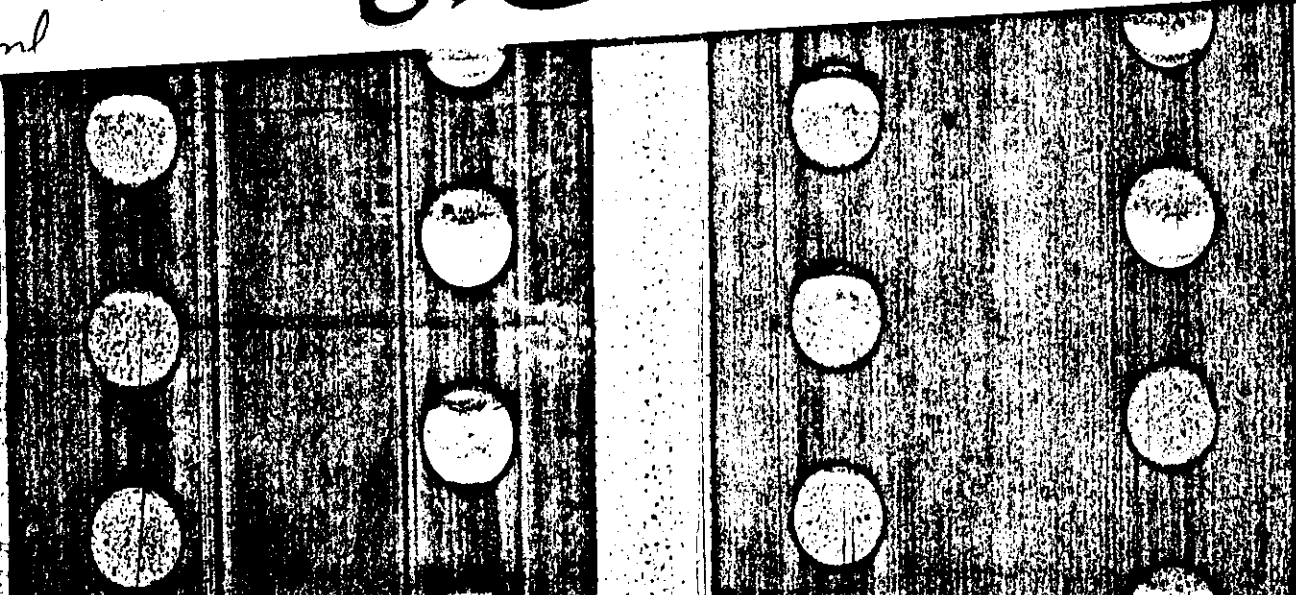

Can I do it, me, a high school dropout, a man that's lucky he can spell his own name, let alone write this type of letter to J. Edger Hoover. No, I can not do it, so what should I do, I did what any God fearing man would do, I went to the Lord and asked him to do it for me.

Where do I start? Oh Lord where do I start, I start by saying what I fill, what I believe.

Mr. Hoover I look upon you as a great man, a great man like our Founding Fathers were and still are great men. But then I wonder, is a man like Mr. Hoover worthy of this compliment? Has or will he make the sacrifice or founding Fathers made, will he pledge his life, his fortunes, and his sacred honor, for that matter will I? Yes I say, yes he will, I know he will, he is the kind of man that loves his country, a country under God.

Mr. Hoover I wrote to you before concerning the CFR. In your return letter you said the FBI was an investigating agency and nothing more. But now I'm writing as a friend, as one American writes to one American and not to the FBI Director. I'm writing to ask for your help, for your help to save our Nation, our Freedoms and our Rights.

I'm sure you know about the CFR, about its plan to rule the world. I also know that legally you can not use the FBI to expose these people. As you know the Birch Society is doing every thing it can to expose them, but we can not do it on a large enough scale. We need help, we need help from wherever it may come. This year we will (or at least I will) be giving our last final effort to beat them, its this year or never, its do or die. This is the last fifteen minutes of the battle, we must win, we have to win.

I could have written the above inquiries direct to the FBI who are the people in this country that know what the communists are doing and I believe know the correct answers; however, I am afraid that if I wrote direct I would not get a true opinion of that Department. The answer may be given from an evasive stereotyped form. In other words, I would receive what is commonly referred to as the "idiot treatment".

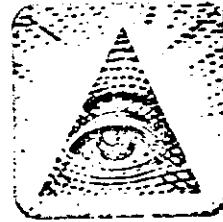
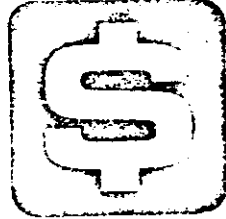

COMMUNISTS CONTROL THE U.N.

by
William E. Dunham

ITEM: From a speech by Secretary of State William P. Rogers on October 4, 1971:

The United Nations is an important instrument of peace . . . Building a structure of peace . . . means that differences exist and will continue to exist . . . One of the functions of a structure of peace is to protect and accommodate those differences, not to destroy them.

CORRECTION: Secretary Rogers displays an appalling willingness to let the International Communist Conspiracy continue to use the United Nations as a basic weapon in its drive to enslave the world.

That the United Nations is an integral part of Communist strategy was stated by Joseph Stalin in 1942 in his book *Marxism And The National Question*, where he wrote that the world should be divided into regional groups as a transitional stage to world government. Then, the regional groups would be brought into a single world dictatorship. Later, on March 23, 1946, *Pravda* quoted Stalin as having declared: "I attribute great importance to U.N.O. since it is a serious instrument for preservation of peace and international security."

Political Affairs is the theoretical organ of the Communist Party, U.S.A. In April 1945 - two months before the San Francisco Conference at which the U.N. was formally created - that journal told its readers: "Great popular support and enthusiasm for the United Nations policies should be built up, well organized and fully articulate . . . The opposition must be rendered so impotent that it will be unable to gather any significant support in the Senate against the United Nations Charter and the treaties which will follow." As Earl Browder, former General Secretary of the Communist Party, U.S.A., and twice its candidate for President of the United States, wrote in his book *Victory And After*: "The American Communists worked energetically and tirelessly to lay the foundations for the United Nations, which we were sure would come into existence."

Just how tirelessly the comrades worked to build this "instrument of peace" was exposed in a study conducted in 1954 by the Senate Internal Security Subcommittee. In a Report entitled *Activities Of United States Citizens Employed By The United Nations* the Subcommittee revealed: "In our investigations of United States citizens employed by the United Nations, we found considerable evidence to indicate that Communists used the same techniques in infiltrating the U.N. Secretariat as had previously been used in infiltrating the United States

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Government. Some of these persons exposed in our government investigation played key roles in the actual establishment of U.N.'s specialized agencies."

Key roles is an accurate phrase. Four years earlier, in 1950, the State Department issued a volume entitled *Postwar Foreign Policy Preparation, 1939-1945*, which listed as important U.S. Government figures in U.N. planning: Alger Hiss, Harry Dexter White, Virginius Frank Coe, Noel Field, Lawrence Duggan, Henry J. Wadleigh, John Carter Vincent, David Weintraub, Nathan G. Silvermaster, Harold Glasser, Victor Perlo, Irving Kaplan, Solomon Adler, Abraham G. Silverman, William L. Ullman, and William H. Taylor. All sixteen were later identified in sworn testimony as secret Communist agents! Communist manipulation of the American delegation at the founding conference was so thorough that identified Communist Dalton Trumbo actually wrote the Report to the Nation delivered at that conference by Secretary of State Edward R. Stettinius.

Were the Communists successful in constructing a vehicle which they could use in their drive to enslave the world? G. Edward Griffin points out in his book, *The Fearful Master: A Second Look At The United Nations*, that "one of the most important positions within the entire United Nations — if not the most important — is that of Undersecretary for Political and Security Council Affairs." Since the U.N. was created, twenty-six years ago, ten different men have held that post, and all ten of them have been Communists!

Consider also the observation by W. Cleon Skousen in his excellent text, *The Naked Communist*: "Anyone familiar with the Communist Constitution of Russia will recognize in the United Nations Charter a similar format. It is characterized by a fervent declaration of democratic principles which are sound and desirable; this is then followed by a constitutional restriction or procedural limitation which completely nullifies the principles just announced!"

Rather than being an "instrument of peace" in the sense in which Americans generally use the phrase, the United Nations is still an integral part of Communist plans. *New Times* is an English-language magazine published weekly in Moscow. In its issue for July 8, 1970, its Communist editors observed: "As stressed by Premier Kosygin at a luncheon for U Thant in Moscow on June 19, the Soviet Union attaches much importance to the United Nations. In future, as in the past, it will spare no effort to steer the Organization's work." Of course not. It was U.N. Secretary-General U Thant, who is a Marxist, who declared in April of 1970 that Lenin's "ideals of peace and peaceful coexistence [meaning no resistance to Communism] are in line with the aims of the U.N. Charter."

Yet Secretary Rogers says the United States should "protect and accommodate" the Communists under the United Nations. Responsible Americans, however, want to *Get US out!* — W.E.D. ■ ■
