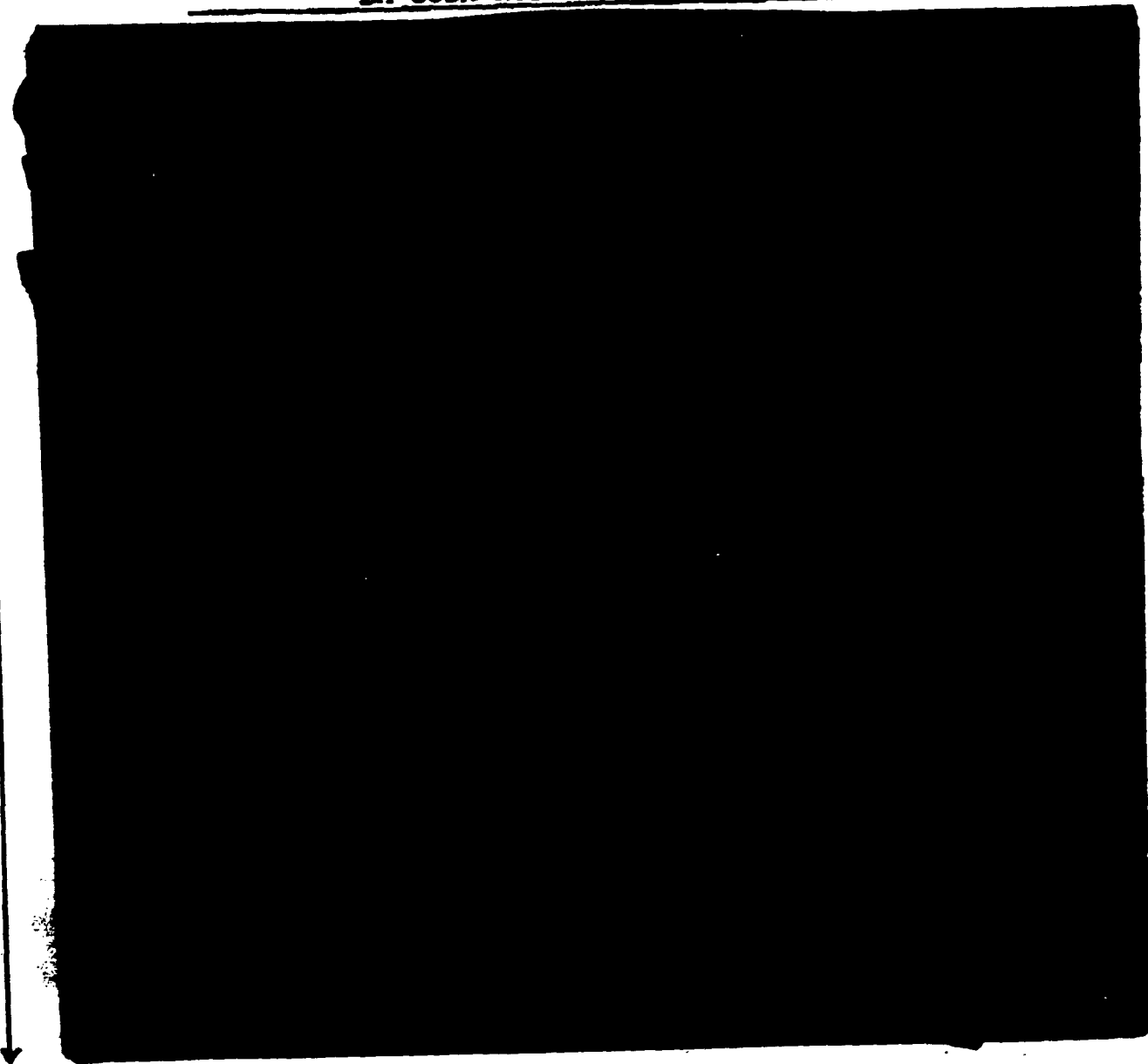

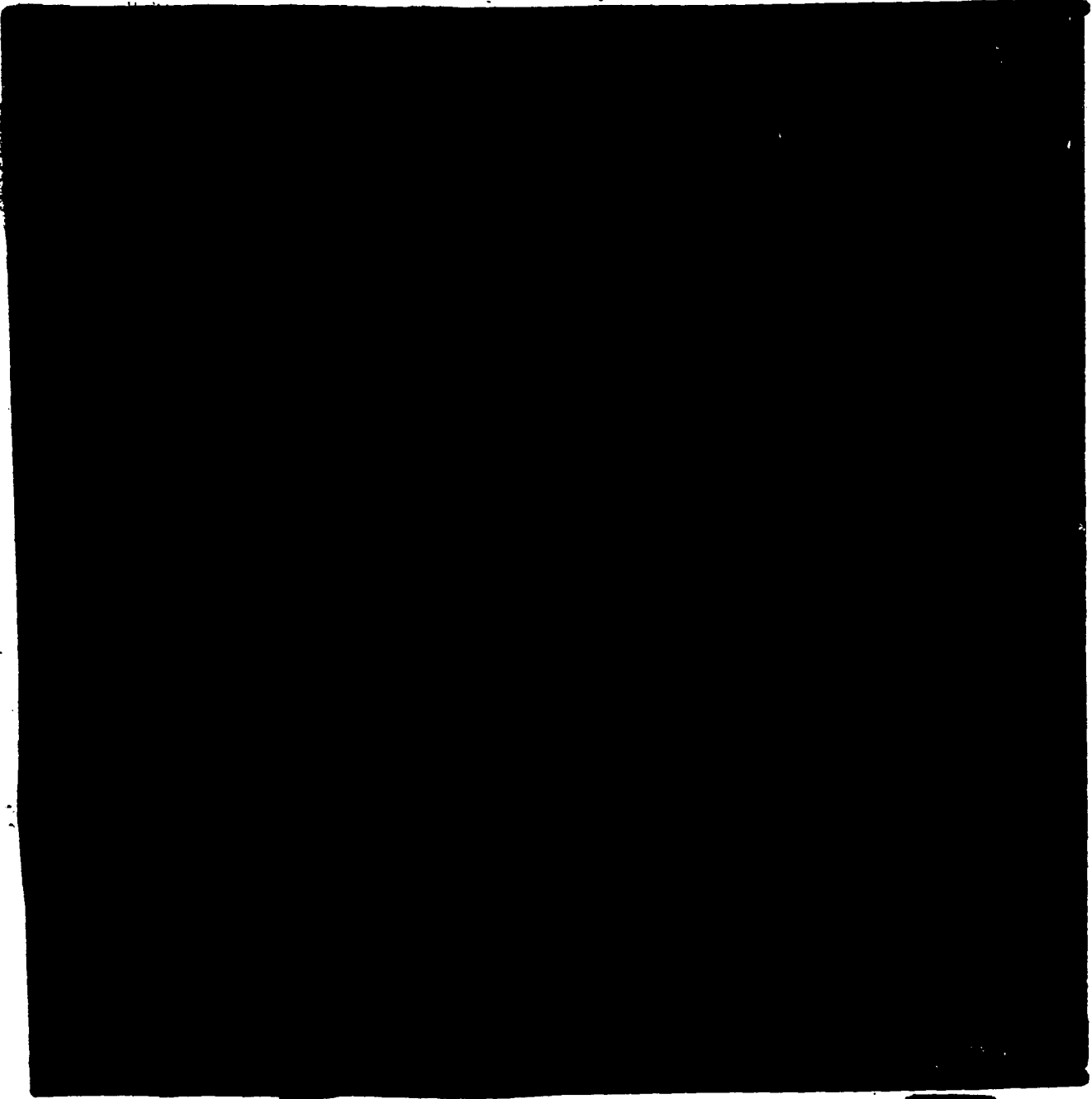

However, it is noted that WHEELOCK WHITNEY, a Republican leader, would not endorse this rally because he considers it a "dump NIXON effort."
