Right-Wing Organizations Increase Anti-Israel Campaign

Several right-wing organizations ranging from the 20,000-member Liberty Lobby to the American Nazis have sharply increased their traditional anti-Israel propaganda, blaming the current fuel shortage here on what they call Jewish or Zionist manipulation of the Mideast crisis.

"Jews Blame . . . for Oil Crisis," says a banner headline on the current issue of White Power, newspaper of the National Socialist White Peoples Party (formerly American Nazi Party).

"Oil Yes — Jews No," reads a bumper sticker being peddled by the National States Rights Party.

"America is being blackmailed," asserts a leaflet distributed in the thousands here by the National Youth Alliance, founded by a former American Nazi Party leader. The blackmailers are a tightly organized, international group of Zionists.

"The cause of this drum-up energy crisis," says Curtis Dall, Liberty Lobby chairman, in an automatic recorded telephone message here, "is the expensive aims of the state of Israel (with) world Zionist leaders and big money aiming to further regiment us by projected ration control."

These and other efforts at fuel crisis publicity have generated what organizers say is a general rejuvenation of the right wing.

"I've never seen anything like it," says William Pierce, head of the Arlington-based National Youth Alliance. "We've already sold about 250,000 'blackmail' leaflets across the country, and we can't keep up with the orders."

"There's been a real resurgence of the right wing over this oil crisis issue," says Edward R. Fields, secretary of the Georgia-based National States Rights Party, which describes itself as a "white racist political party."

Fields said his organization recently printed 10,000 "Oil Yes—Jews No" bumper stickers and already has sold more than 1,000 at four for \$1. Circulation of the party's newspaper, The Thunderbolt, has also jumped from 12,000 to 14,000 in recent months, he said.

Spokesmen for all organizations said their publicity efforts are self-supporting and they say receive no support from Arab or oil interests.

"We've been watching this matter very closely," says Arnold Forster, general counsel for the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith, which monitors organizations considered by it to be anti-Jewish.

A "kind of empirically weighted study" by ADL of newspaper editorials across the country, he said, shows that only a "lunatic fringe" of "extremist bigots" blame the oil shortage on Israel or American Jews.

The shortage has provided a timely pretext to boost anti-Jewish propaganda, Forster said. "It's part of their lunatic thinking," he said.

The thrust of much of the

terests in Congress and the Nixon administration has led to almost unlimited financial and military support of Israel. This in turn triggered reductions in oil supplies by the Arab nations to the United States, according to the literature.

At a minimum, the organizations urge elimination of U.S. aid to Israel and withdrawal of Israeli troops to the 1967 borders.

"We can restore the oil imports we need to keep the country running if we refuse to knuckle under to Zionists

can money or weapons be sent to the Middle East and that the media monopolies in this country be broken up, we can put the Zionist blackmailers out of business."

Pierce, of the youth alliance, would not reveal membership totals for the organization. He said he has been steadily shipping 100-pound bundles of the leaflets across the country at 1,000 copies for \$12 or 10,000 copies for \$100. In addition, the oil crisis has been a leading subject in the organization's 16,000-circulation newspaper, "Attack!" which has

Capitol Hill recently with thousands of the "blackmail" leaflets printed on bright yellow paper.

In a similar action, Fields and several others from the National States Rights Party visited Washington last week, left copies of a protest letter at the offices of numerous senators and representatives, then picketed the White House.

Fields said in a telephone interview from his headquarters in suburban Atlanta that the current issue of the party's 16,000-circulation newspaper

"I think the Jews are the spot," he said. "I think they pin their ears back on the issue. We're going all out."

Likewise, spokesmen for the National Socialist White Peoples Party in Arlington, Va., their monthly paper, White Power, sold out in November and December.

At party headquarters, 1000 N. Franklin Rd., yesterday, a security guard wearing a .38-caliber pistol on one hip and a canister of chemical mace in the other refused to let into the party's membership offices or newspaper circulation office.

Liberty Lobby, the party's most influential group, with headquarters at 300 Independence Ave. S.W., says in its current newsletter

"Whether by rationing gasoline or . . . by driving up the price of gas to \$1 a gallon, the effect is the same—the theft of a conceptual battle that puts Israel ahead of our own country . . . Let us defend our national interests where the Israelis

where we live. American Liberty Lobby spokesmen say their organization is "a constitutionalist organization distinct from 'right wing'."

They also emphasize their opposition is to Zionists, not to Jews who support the United States, as distinguished from Jewish persons in general.

The Zionist "program" for the United States, says Dall in the current issue of the party's "gradual destruction of the United States."

Purpose of this memorandum is to obtain your approval to disseminate through our liaison office to the U. S. Internal Revenue Service (IRS) and the Chief Postal Inspector copies of reports setting forth results of our investigation of the NYA.

The NYA is an organization originally formed from a nucleus of a Youth for (George C.) Wallace supporters following the 1968 Presidential election for the purpose of countering radical leftist and anarchist influences of American colleges and universities. NYA currently is controlled by individuals who militantly promote white racism and anti-Semitism and who suggest violent influences as the means for implementing their radical and political ideals in America. The NYA publishes a newspaper entitled "Attack" which espouses the aims and purposes of the organization. This group has been under investigation by the FBI since 1969.

An informative note was prepared on 12/26/73 to which was attached an article, which appeared in "The Washington Post" daily newspaper, authored by Jack Anderson. The article pointed out that the NYA has achieved tax exempt status from the IRS and reduced postal rates from the U. S. Postal Service as it is classified as a nonprofit organization. Neither IRS nor the U. S. Postal Service has previously been furnished with results of our investigations. *REC-127* is believed that the NYA is an active extremist organization and in view of the above, dissemination should be made of reports which have been prepared on this organization since 1969 to the IRS and Chief Postal Inspector.

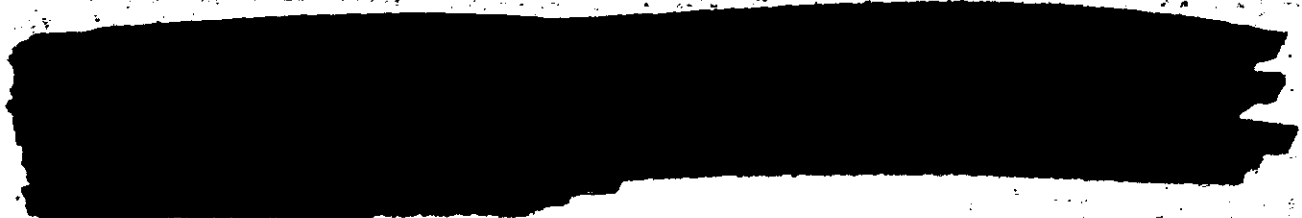

Ex-Nazi's Hate Group Is Tax Exempt

By Jack Anderson

Under President Nixon, public interest groups have found it increasingly difficult to obtain tax exemptions from the Internal Revenue Service.

Yet a former Nazi, who once promised there would be "a Jew hanging from every lamppost in the country," had no trouble breezing through the bureaucratic morass at the IRS and getting his hate organization declared "exempt from federal income tax."

He is William L. Pierce, who runs the anti-Semitic, right-wing National Youth Alliance in Arlington, Va. Pierce, who has a Ph.D. in physics and prefers to be called "doctor," was a self-admitted "personal friend" of George Lincoln Rockwell, the late fuhrer of the American Nazi Party. After Rockwell's death, Pierce became the Nazis' "assistant executive officer" and "ideological officer."

It was in this capacity that Pierce recorded a "dial-a-hate" message declaring "there is only one effective way to deal with rampaging blacks on our campuses — and in our cities — and that is to kill them."

In 1968, Pierce was found selling "Negro control equipment" out of his Virginia home. His "equipment" ranged from riot guns to chemical mace.

For the past three years,

Pierce has headed the National Youth Alliance, an offshoot of the arch-conservative Liberty Lobby. The original NYA, which was based in Washington, went out of business and, in 1970, was reincorporated in Virginia by Pierce.

The "new" NYA is largely a paper organization which does little more than publish hate literature and send out appeals for funds.

Its main publication is a tabloid called "Attack," which is frequently festooned with ghoulish pictures of maimed and disfigured bodies. They are described in rabid language as Arabs who fell victim to Israeli attacks.

A recent fund-raising letter asserted that "only a well-aimed bullet could have stopped the confirmation of Henry Kissinger..."

This scurrilous literature is now produced tax free. For as of October, 1973, Pierce's organization is no longer required to pay federal taxes.

A letter to Pierce from IRS District Director William D. Waters proclaims that the NYA is "not liable for Social Security (FICA) taxes" or for "the taxes imposed under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act (FUTA)." All "bequests, legacies, devises, transfers or gifts" to the NYA are also "deductible for federal estate gift tax purposes."

What's more, Pierce took his tax-exempt credentials to the Postal Service and wangled the privilege of mailing his literature at the reduced rates reserved for non-profit organizations.

Now, courtesy of the U.S. government, Pierce saves \$310 for every 10,000 pieces of hate mail he sends out.

Pierce's most recent issue of "Attack" which he mailed at non-profit rates, contains a picture of Kissinger in the crosshairs of a rifle telescope. The same issue advertises Adolf Hitler's "Mein Kampf" and several "how-to" books on the construction of booby-traps, explosives and demolitions.

Footnote: An IRS spokesman told us that tax exempt status is usually granted on the presumption that "the organization has acted in good faith and has told us the "truth" about its operations. There are over 600,000 tax-exempt groups on record, the spokesman said, explaining it is impossible to investigate them all. Nevertheless, the IRS found plenty of time to investigate the Center on Corporate Responsibility, a public interest group that struggled three years for a tax exemption and won it only after a federal judge detected "political" influence

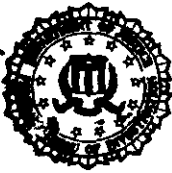

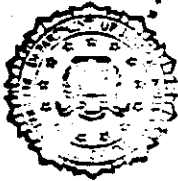

II. OBJECTIVES AND PROGRAMS

An interview with WILLIAM L. PIERCE, Executive Director of NYA, printed in "The Journal", a weekly newspaper published at Arlington, Virginia, in its issue of April 26, 1973, is quoted in part as follows:

"One of NYA's credos is that racial tension and hatred are the inevitable outcome of a racially mixed society.

"Separation is the only answer,' according to PIERCE. He predicted 'if we remain in our present course we're heading for cultural, national and racial choas. We already have it to some extent.'"

"NYA opposes all racially mixed marriages, as well as marriages between Jews and Christians. It is against forced racial mixing in schools, employment and housing.

"'You might say we agree with the Black Muslims in spirit, since we're both concerned that our peoples should be able to develop according to our own natures,' PIERCE observed. 'We should think of the race as the central entity, and the individual as a part of the race.'

"ABRAHAM LINCOLN, touted as the man who abolished slavery, wanted separate futures for blacks and whites after abolition, according to PIERCE. 'LINCOLN and most abolitionists wanted to settle former slaves in Africa or the Caribbean.'

"Racial pride is one answer for students without any apparent sense of community or value, according to NYA. 'Life is just a series of kicks to many of them. Drugs are just one outcome of this attitude of doing what you damn well please without any responsibility to anyone else,' PIERCE said.

"NYA also opposes Zionism, and U.S. aid to Israel against the Palestinians forced to leave the country. Unlike other groups termed 'right-wing,' it wants stronger rein on big business, saying that U.S. power is held by one wealth-accumulating class."

The NYA recruiting leaflet entitled "The Future Belongs to Us-Join Us!", sets forth the objectives and program of the NYA in fundamental terms. A reproduction of this leaflet appears in the appendix section of this report as Exhibit I.
