

At 3:05 p.m., 6/29/63, Assistant Director Courtney A. Evans advised SA David Ryan, Weekend Supervisor, Domestic Intelligence Division, that the Attorney General had made inquiry regarding an article appearing in the "New York Journal American" regarding this case. Mr. Evans stated the article indicated a "high elected American official" was involved with this scandal. The Attorney General stated the President had expressed concern regarding this matter.

SA Michael O'Rourke, Weekend Supervisor, New York Office, telephonically advised this newspaper article was entitled "High U. S. Aide Implicated in V-Girl Scandal" and contained the by-line of James D. Horan and Dom Frasca. The article purported to be the result of a 20 minute trans-Atlantic taped interview between the newspapermen and Maria Novotny and her spokesman British newspaperman Peter Earle,

The article stated "One of the highest names in American politics, a holder of a very high elective office, has been injected into Britain's vice-security scandal." The article stated Novotny identified one Suzy Chang as the former paramour of this American official.

After giving a rehash of the background of this case, the article appeared to conclude that it was "apparent that Chang, Novotny and Keeler were linked in a web of international vice activity."

This information was telephonically furnished to Mr. Evans and he instructed that New York should make no inquiries at the "Journal American" regarding this article but that such inquiries would be handled through Mr. DeLoach. New York was advised accordingly.



They registered at the Hotel Bedford, 118 East 40th Street, New York City, July 11, 1962. They checked out of this hotel on July 14, 1962, and reregistered on July 16, 1962. Hotel records do not show the date of departure; however, they did leave the U. S. on July 18, 1962, by British Overseas Airways Corporation plane. 71

The Legal Attache, London, forwarded copies of memoranda prepared by Alfred Wells, Secretary to Ambassador Bruce, concerning various persons involved in the instant case. In a memorandum dated 11/6/62 Wells stated that he had attended a dinner the night before at which he had met Dr. Stephen Ward and that Ward had made loud statements that he had been the principal liaison between the Soviets and the British Government during the Cuban crisis. He spoke concerning the confidential messages he carried between Ivanov and his "friends" in the British Government. Wells stated that he asked the man sitting next to him who Dr. Ward was and the man stated that he was an osteopath and that he procured girls for wealthy clients. By memorandum 6/18/63 Mr. Wells stated he had been to a luncheon on 2/13/63 with Thomas Corbally, Dr. Ward, Mrs. Robin Dalton, an Australian woman, and William Hitchcock.

Wells also wrote a memorandum dated 6/18/63 in which he stated that Thomas Corbally on 2/5/63 told Clive Bossom, Parliamentary Private Secretary to the Secretary of State for Air Hugh Fraser and Wells that Christine Keeler was selling a story about her affairs with Profumo Ivanov, and others. Wells continued that on 6/17/63 Mr. Bossom told him that shortly after 2/5/63 he had passed Corbally's statements on to Fraser and Profumo and that Profumo had stated, "There are always rumors about men in the limelight."

By memorandum dated 1/29/63 Wells recorded a convention he had with Thomas Corbally in which Corbally said that Miss Enter and Miss Davies had sold an article to the "Sunday Pictorial" in which they list the various men with whom the had slept. The memorandum stated that the impending scandal had been brought to the attention of the Prime Minister on the evening of 1/28/63 and a letter had been written to the above paper putting the paper on notice that the Government is aware of the story and under British law the story could not be published until after the trial of the Jamaican, who was being charged with attempting to murder Keeler.

Wells had also recalled a telephone call he had taken from a Mrs. Aires, who had rented her apartment to a Mr. Hitchcock, who in turn had recommended a Mr. Corbally to take over the apartment. Mrs. Aires pointed out that in February of this year a great deal of publicity occurred concerning girls being taken to the apartment. She said that Corbally had paid his rent through February, but owed an enormous amount for telephone bills, electricity, and other charges. She also complained about the destruction of furniture in the apartment.








The file reflects that MARIA HOVOTNY has stated that she went on prostitution dates with Bara BATA was interviewed by various agencies, including grand juries of NY County and "Southern Judicial District, NY". Her testimony was negative regarding obtaining admissions of her prostitution.

She admitted knowing TOWERS (HARRY ALLAN TOWERS) and MARIA NOVOTNY, claiming that she met them through a boy friend whom she refused to identify. However, the file indicates that this boy friend is one who was formerly connected with the National Telefilm Associates.

BATA has made several trips to Europe since entry into the US, claiming that such trips were to visit her mother, who had been able to leave Hungary for these trips.

During a trip in November 2

During a trip in November, 1960, BATA stated that her mother had given her \$12,000.00. She said that her boy friend (unidentified by BATA) had paid for her ticket to Europe and after meeting her mother she joined her boy friend in Paris and admitted that they shared a fite room suite in an unknown hotel. The file indicates that BATA returned on the same plane with her boy friend.

When questioned by INS on 4/19/61, relative to her source of income, BATA stated that she has been financed by her family and also by an unidentified boy friend.

The INS file indicates that ILONA BATA married one HUBERT CHRISTIE, a native born US citizen, on 9/5/61. HUBERT CHRISTIE's address is indicated in the file as 3650 Southwest 19th Street, Miami, Florida.

regarding ILONA BATA but she indicated when she first arrived in the country that she was going to be a mode and that she hoped to study at New York University.

The file contained a memo dated 6/20/63 indicating that the file of ILONA BATA CHRISTIE is being reviewed by INS at the request of AUSA PETER FLEMING SDNY, at the direction of AUSA STEPHEN E, KAUFMAN, Assistant Chief, Criminal Division, SDNY, The purposes of the review is to determine whether CHRISTIE might be knowledgeable of any facts which would relate to the TOWERS-DIBBEN affair or to the PROFUMO case.

Mr. FLEMMING made known the fact that one SONYA SCHLUETER, one-time witness to the naturalization petition of CHRISTIE, was arrested by the NYCPD in March, 1962 for soliciting for purposes of prostitution while utilizing CHRISTIE's apartment and telephone.

Mr. FLEMMING made observations that a review of CHRISTIE's file leads him to the conclusion that she would not be a cooperative withess in any inquiry looking to prosecution of federal criminal violations.

It will be noted that the above memo relative to the review requested by the USA's office, SDNY, appeared to be an administrative directive and therefore information obtained from this memo, if used, should be carefully paraphrased to protect the source.

The file also reflects that ILONA BATA CHRISTIE and her attorney, MARVIN H. NEWMAN, 130 West 58th Street, NYC, appeared for a hearing at INS on 5/21/62. This hearing was conducted by Investigator, INS. NEWMAN advised his client not to answer any questions if these questions concerned her immigration status. He stated that she would be free to answer questions relative to her naturalization. When NEWMAN was advised by that the questions concerned BATA's immigration status, NEWMAN advised his client not to answer any questions and the hearing was terminated.

Regarding the security aspects of captioned investigation, it is noted that during conversations with Investigator the latter stated he is thoroughly familiar with the CHRISTIE investigation in no situations regarding internal security have come to his attention.




