Nixon Names Seattle Man As Counsel

By a Washington Post Staff Writer

NEW YORK, Nov. 14—President-elect Nixon named a third top member of his White House staff today and announced plans to hold his first post-election meeting with representatives of Negro, labor and business groups.

The President-elect named John D. Ehrlichman, 43, a Seattle attorney and longtime staffer, as Counsel to the President.

Shortly thereafter, he announced that he would meet separately Friday with Whitney Young, president of the Urban League, AFL-CIO President George Meany and Frederic A. Kappel, board chairman of AT&T and a leader in various business groups.

The meetings with Young and Meany, both of whom speak for millions of Americans who voted against the Republican candidate Nov. 5, are designed to open a dialogue with those groups.

Intelligence Briefing

Also on Friday, the President-elect will receive an intelligence briefing from CIA Director Richard M. Helms, who will fly here from Washington for the appointment.

Late Friday, the President-elect will fly to Key Biscayne, Fla., for several days of rest and work.

Ehrlichman will have the

title of Counsel to the President. Previous holders of the post have been called Special Counsel to the President, but H. R. (Bob) Haldeman, a newly named assistant to the President, said yesterday that title would be eliminated "as such."

Asked what the difference is between counsel and special counsel, Ehrlichman said, "There has been an effort to re-title in order that there will be no mistake about the content of the positions. The new appointees will not necessarily have the same duties as in some other administrations.

Little Speechwriting

"There will be very little speechwriting by the counsel in this Administration," he added in obvious reference to Theodore C. Sorensen in the Kennedy Administration and Harry McPherson in the Johnson Administration.

Ehrlichman said that he would be the legal adviser to the President and undertake "such other assignments as he may give me."

At the moment, Ehrlichman said, he is primarily engaged in personnel recruitment, but he said he did not expect to concentrate on that after Jan. 20.

Ron Ziegler, spokesman for the President-elect, said that Ehrlichman would be on the same level on the White House staff as Haldeman and Bryce N. Harlow, another assistant to the President.

Ehrlichman received his A.B. degree from the University of California and his law degree from Stanford University. He is a member of the Seattle law firm of Hullin, Ehrlichman, Roberts and Hodge.

He has worked in all of Nixon's campaigns since 1960, with the title of Tour Director in 1968. He is a native of Tacoma. He and his wife have five children.

ADDENDUM (1/28/69), CDD:CSH -

For record purposes, I called Mr. Krogh and asked if there was some specific reason, or failure on our part, which prompted John Ehrlichman's office to issue instructions to SA George Saunders of our Washington Field Office to the effect that no further interviews were to be conducted of White House personnel, in special inquiry-type cases. u

Mr. Krogh informed me that Bob Haldeman, President Nixon's top assistant, and John Ehrlichman, the President's Legal Counsel, both felt that it is an insult to their intelligence to be interviewed regarding the backgrounds of people they have known for a number of years. He stated that both Haldeman and Ehrlichman had expressed the opinion that they know these people enough so that interviews of White House personnel are not warranted. Krogh added that, of course, Haldeman and Ehrlichman would not have appointed these people in the first place if they had felt or believed something derogatory was in their backgrounds. u

I told Mr. Krogh that these investigations are, of course, strictly for the protection of the President and his administration. I stated that actually such investigations represent "insurance" against embarrassment to the President and his staff. Krogh stated he realized all this and that he wanted to discuss the matter further with Ehrlichman and would call me back. u

Mr. Krogh did call me back within 15 minutes and stated that SA Saunders should continue White House interviews, according to the usual custom; however, under no circumstances should either Haldeman or Ehrlichman be interviewed at any time. He reiterated the same excuses given above as to why no interviews of Haldeman or Ehrlichman should be conducted. He particularly stated that Haldeman felt that such interviews were unnecessary. u

I told Mr. Krogh that Lyndon Johnson had known Walter Jenkins for approximately 24 years, yet had not known of the homosexual incidents in Jenkins' background. Krogh stated he had informed Ehrlichman of this same case; however, Ehrlichman had claimed that there were no homosexuals among his staff. Krogh reiterated that both Haldeman and Ehrlichman felt that such interviews were a waste of their time. I told Mr. Krogh that we would be guided by his instructions and no further interviews would be conducted with Haldeman or Ehrlichman. u
