member, testified that in the summer of 1937, the Communist party was carrying on an extensive campaign to assist the Loyalist Government of Spain in its war against FRANCISCO FRANCO. All Communist party members were to take part in the campaign to raise money.

The "People's World" newspaper, issue of October 21, 1939, page 3, carried an article which stated that the campaign committee of ARCHIE BROWN, Communist endorsed candidate for Supervisor in San Francisco, announced that BROWN was being endorsed by the CWMAA.

It is noted that the October 24, 1942 issue of the "People's World" quoted ARCHIE BROWN as saying: "I am an American, a longshoreman, and a communist."

The "People's World", now known as the "Daily People's World", is a West Coast Communist newspaper.

The "People's World" newspaper issue of December 7, 1939 carried an article which advised that the CWMAA was sponsoring "International Night in Chinatown", to take place on December 24, 1939. According to this article, the purpose of the affair was to raise funds for the "People's World" newspaper.

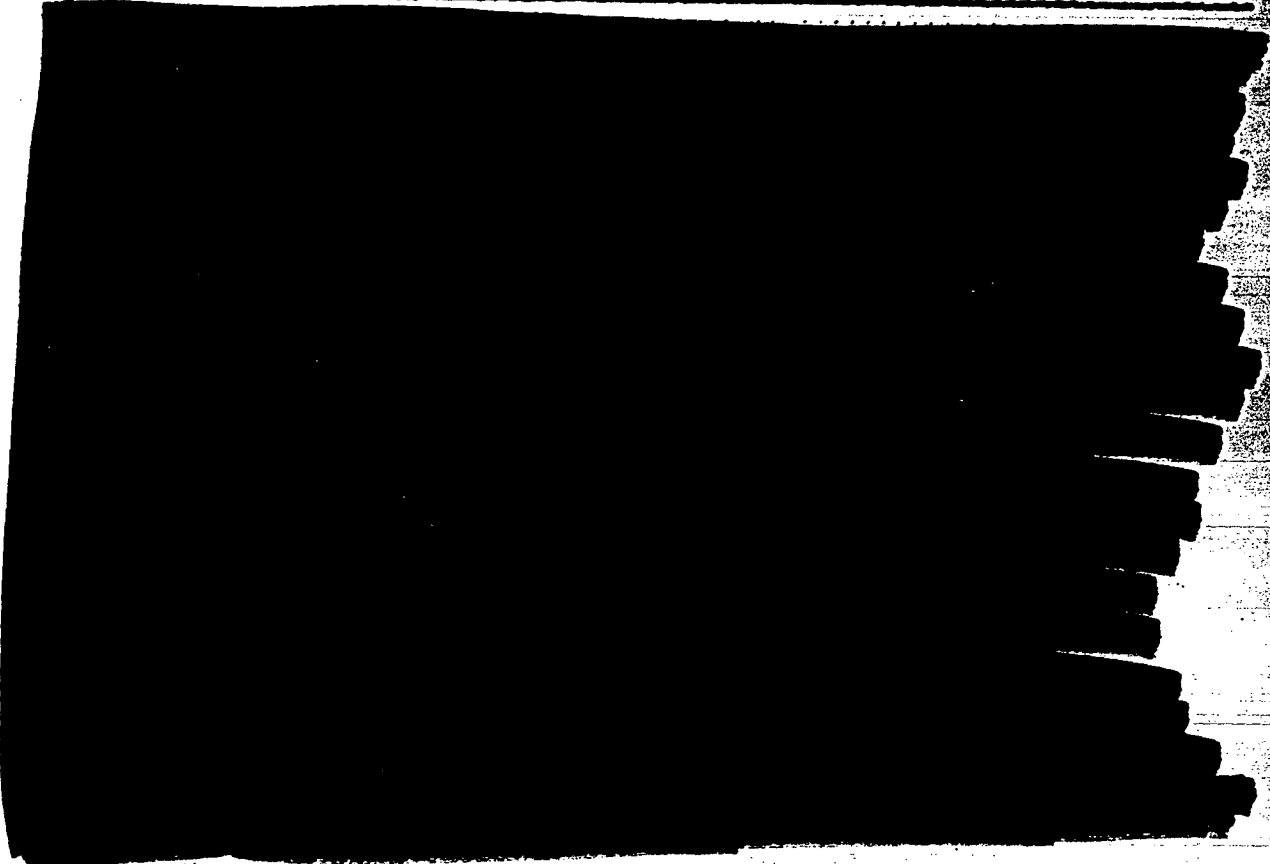
