Philip J. Wise, Jr., Appointments Secretary to the President of the United States, was interviewed at his office in the White House.

He was advised of the official identity of the interviewing Agent and told that he was being interviewed about a possible violation of the Foreign Agents Registration Act by William A. (Billy) Carter, III. Mr. Wise voluntarily furnished the following information:

He reviewed his telephone log, listing calls he received at the White House, for the period October 1, 1978, through January 11, 1979.

During this time, he received no telephone calls from Billy Carter and has not been asked by him to intervene with anyone at the United States Department of State (USDS) on behalf of Billy Carter or the country of Libya concerning the sale or release of airplanes to Libya.


If he had been asked to become involved in contracts or the sale of airplanes by Billy Carter, he would have referred the matter to the National Security Council (NSC), rather than referring him to anyone at the USDS.

He does not normally deal with the USDS and would not act as a go-between for Billy Carter with that agency.

At this point, he was specifically asked if the log or record of telephone calls were subpoensed by the court in this investigation if there would be no record of any call logged therein for the period October 1, 1978, through January 11, 1979, from Billy Carter to him.

He stated "I can't say we (his staff) could not have missed" or failed to record one, but none were found in the review of the log for that period.

In order to get a clearer perspective of this case, they were advised to discuss the areas dealing with classified matters with Mr. Michael Epstein, representative of the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence (SSCI), who is dealing with the classified material.

In order to be responsive and to provide a chronological and logical explanation of this investigation, aspects dealing with sources and techniques were discussed in general terms.

Tiefer advised he would reduce his interview to memorandum form and requested it be reviewed, prior to having it placed in the public record, to insure that no classified information is set forth.

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The question was raised as to what information had been furnished to the Director. They were advised that the file had been reviewed on 7/31/80, for such information and were furnished the information set forth in R. T. Castonguay to E. J. O'Malley memorandum dated 7/31/80. Tiefer indicated he would desire to explore the above question further and was advised to coordinate this with Mr. R. J. Bruemmer.

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They requested copies of photographs identifed in Atlanta airtel 7/10/80 and were advised we would furnish copies and negatives.

Tiefer advised his request to contact Legat, Rome, would be delayed.



RE: SENATE INTELLIGENCE COMMITTEE INQUIRY INTO BILLY CARTER - LIBYAN ACTIVITIES

Senator Bayh called today to explain his proposed method of handling intelligence information and access to same during this investigation. It was his thought that staff members Bill Miller, Mike Epstein and David Shaw would assist the special counsel in this matter, Judge Tone, Bob Kelly and Michael Davidson, and that the latter three would prepare a report which could go to the investigating committee and the investigators which would not disclose sources and methods. He stated his awareness that Mr. McDermott was a former Agent but preferred to proceed as tightly as possible on this information. He further stated that he was contacting Admiral Turner to advise him of this policy.

Apparently Mr. Kelly already has top secret clearance and an application for clearance of Mr. Davidson was made on August 1st. We do not know whether any processing for Judge Tone has taken place. We ought to be certain that we are on top of any such application and move them forward swiftly. If there is any question about who will need clearances, perhaps Mr. Nolan ought to contact Bill Miller.
