AT THIS TIME, ATLANTA HAS NOT RECEIVED OFFICIAL NOTIFICATION OF KING HUSSEIN'S VISIT TO ATHENS, GEORGIA, THROUGH U.S. SECRET SERVICE; HOWEVER, UNIVERSITY OF GEORGIA HAS ADVISED FBI ATLANTA AND THE LOCAL USSS REPRESENTATIVE OF KING HUSSEIN'S IMPENDING VISIT. ATLANTA FBI IS A MEMBER OF A JOINT TERRORIST TASK FORCE WHICH INCLUDES A LOCAL USSS REPRESENTATIVE. THE USSS REPRESENTATIVE ADVISED THERE HAS BEEN NO OFFICIAL CONFIRMATION OF THE IMPENDING VISIT AT THIS TIME.

SUPPORT PROVIDED BY ATLANTA FBI TO CAPTIONED EVENT WILL CONSIST PRIMARILY OF PASSING INTELLIGENCE INFORMATION TO THE USSS, CONDUCTING LIAISON WITH THE NUMEROUS LAW ENFORCEMENT AND INTELLIGENCE AGENCIES RESPONSIBLE FOR SECURITY OF CAPTIONED MATTER, AND DEVELOPING DETAILED CONTINGENCY PLANS IN THE EVENT A CREDIBLE THREAT TO KING HUSSEIN IS IDENTIFIED AND FBI JURISDICTION IS ASSUMED.

ATLANTA WILL MAINTAIN APPROPRIATE LIAISON WITH USSS LOCALLY TO ENSURE CHANNELS OF COMMUNICATION REMAIN OPEN AND FUNCTION IN SUCH A MANNER THAT ENSURES INTELLIGENCE WILL CONTINUE TO BE PROVIDED ON A TIMELY BASIS, ESPECIALLY THAT

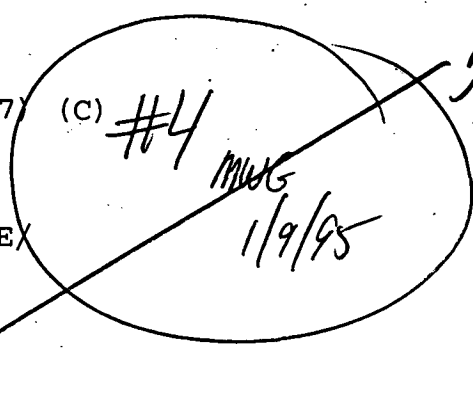

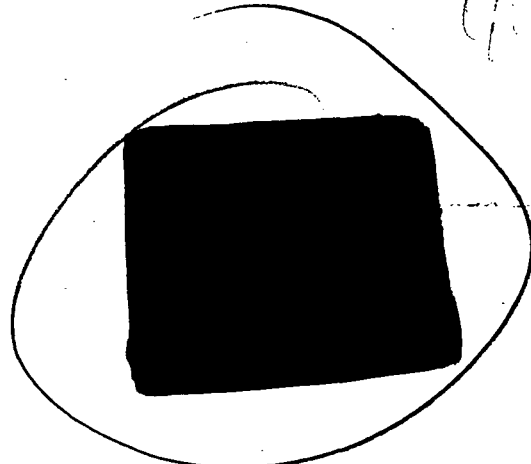

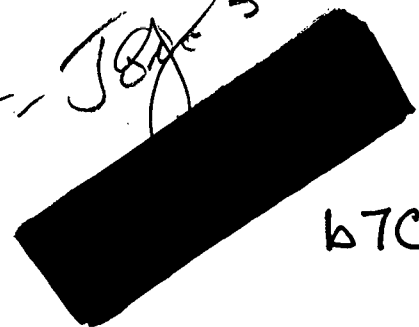
