CONTACT APRIL 25, 1980, WITH PACE CONCERTS INCORPORATED, HOUSTON, TEXAS, DETERMINED THAT ROCK GROUP "KISS" PERFORMED IN HOUSTON, OCTOBER 21, 1979, AT THE SUMMIT. THERE WERE NO INCIDENTS NOR ANY DAMAGE OCCURRING DURING CONCERT AT HOUSTON. "KISS" DID NOT PLAY IN ANY OTHER CITIES COVERED BY HOUSTON DIVISION.

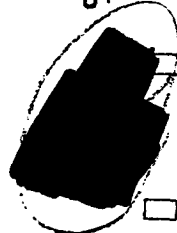
