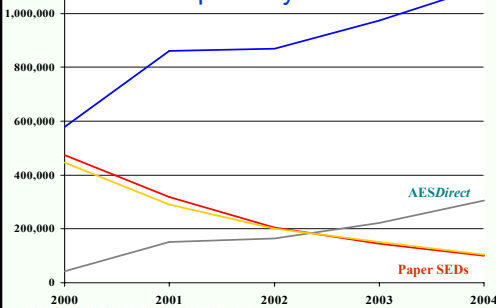

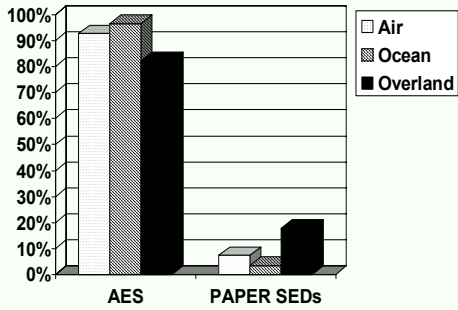
Exports by Source

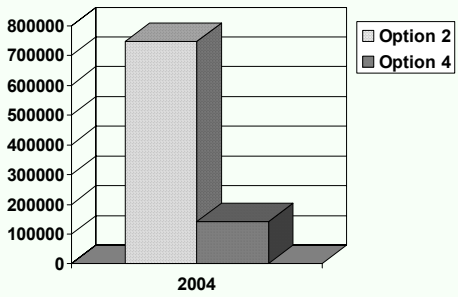

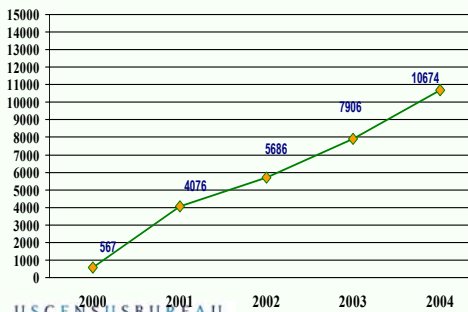

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Items on the CCL and USML must be filed in AES • Removed AES Filing Option 3 • Reduced Data Entry Center privileges • Proof of Filing Citations required when cargo is tendered to the exporting carrier • Moratorium on new Option 4 applications

AES Commodity Redesign

- Test Region available – April 5, 2004
 - Vendors and Self-Programmers MUST test
- Production Implementation- June 8, 2004
- A “Replace” shipment filing action will take the place of the “Delete” and “Add” action used to change data
- Increase the number of business edits
- CBP introduces a “Compliance Alert” message
- Response Messages will be modified

Option 4 Proposed Changes

- New Letter of Intent (LOI) requirements
- Only USPPIs can submit the LOI; Forwarders will no longer be able to submit Option 4 LOIs on behalf of their clients
- USPPIs will be measured against higher compliance levels
- Minimum volume of export shipments
 - Exceptions will be made for certain commodities

AESDirect/AESPcLink Enhancements

- Virtual Private Network (VPN) connection
 - Two-way exchange of data between the companies computer and the AESDirect Service.
- AESPcLink Server Version
 - Available mid-April 2004
 - Load the AESPcLink software to a companies server.
