The Board of Judges of the Eastern District of New York, at a meeting held on June

22, 2004, resolved to complete the electronic case filing project begun in 1997.

Beginning on August 2, 2004, electronic case filing will be mandatory for all civil

cases other than pro se cases and for all criminal cases.

Requests by attorneys for an exemption to the mandatory policy will be considered

for good cause hardship reasons only, and will be reviewed on an individual basis by the

assigned United States Magistrate Judge. The Clerk's Office provides an electronic filing

training program to assist attorneys filing electronically. Before seeking a hardship

exemption, attorneys are advised to participate in the training program or otherwise seek

the assistance of the Clerk's Office.
