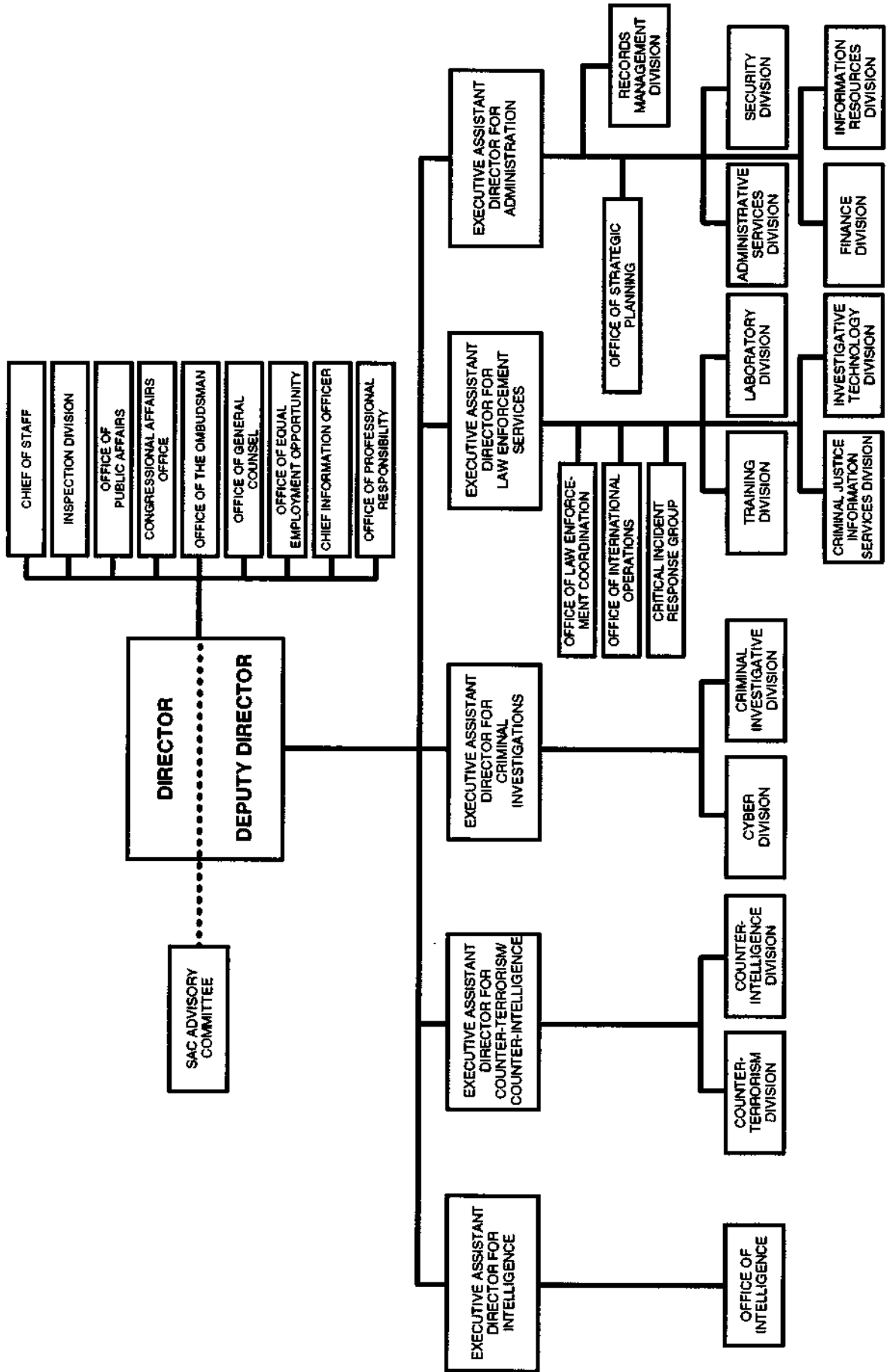
SUBJECT: Reorganization of the Federal Bureau of Investigation

I approve the organizational changes for the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) that reflect final approval by the House and Senate following their review of our May 2003 proposal. Specifically, the committees agreed with the plan to establish a new Executive Assistant Director for Intelligence (EADI); realign the Office of Intelligence to report to the EADI; separate the Office of Public and Congressional Affairs into two separate offices; realign the Office of Strategic Planning to report to the Executive Assistant Director for Administration; and realign the Office of Professional Responsibility to report to the Director's Office. However, the committees did not agree to eliminate the current Executive Assistant Director for Criminal Investigations position. In addition, the committees directed that program management for the FBI's Foreign Terrorist Tracking Task Force should remain within the Counterterrorism Division. A signed copy of the new official organization chart of the FBI is attached.

You should now take appropriate steps to implement this reorganization, including any Code of Federal Regulations changes that may be necessary.

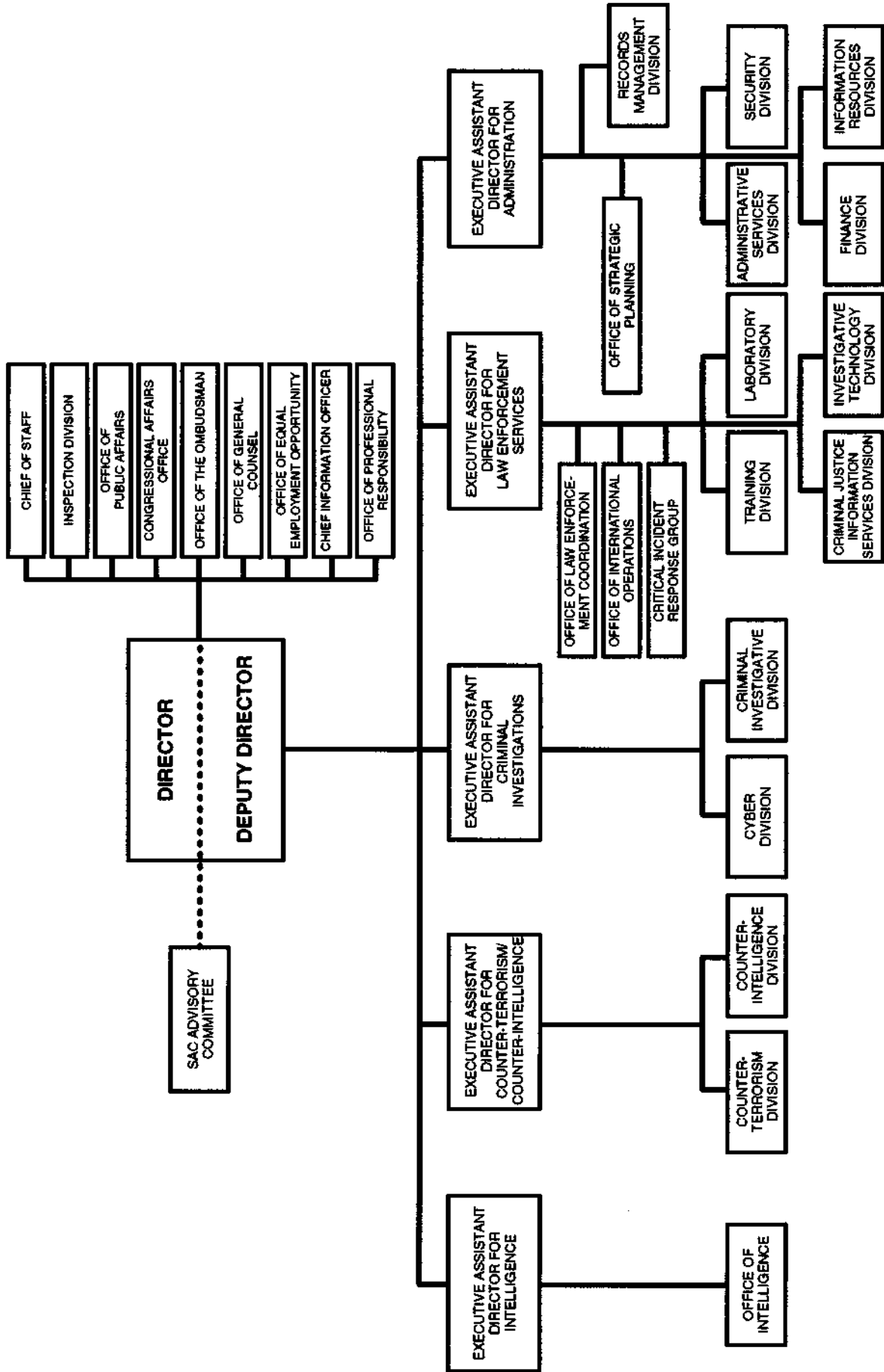

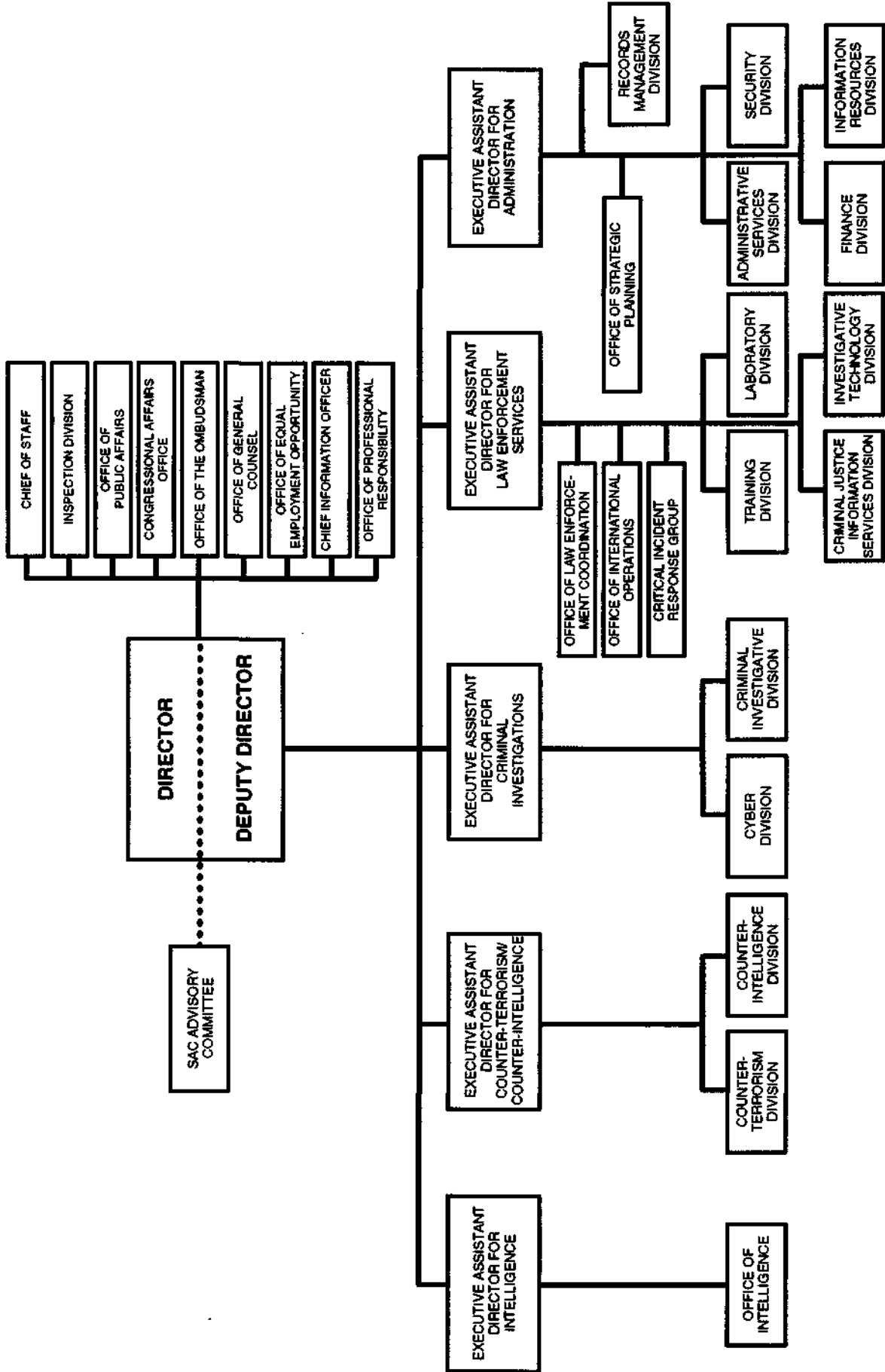
