1. PURPOSE:

The purpose of this directive is to:

Fidelity and Casualty of New York, a member company of CAN, with Rutherfoord International as the administrative broker, provides Defense Base Act (DBA) coverage to USAID direct and host country contractors under contract HNE-Q-98-00163-00. Contract HNE-Q-98-00163-00 was awarded June 30, 1998 for a two-year base period with three one-year options. The current contract was modified on June 23, 2003 to extend the period of performance from July 1, 2003 to September 30, 2003. The rate for the extended period of performance is \$1.44 per \$100 of employee remuneration.
