Public Safety Officers' Education Assistance Program

This funding will allow OJP to begin to extend this program to the dependants of federal, state, and local public safety officers who have been killed in the line of duty on or after May 1, 1978, or disabled in the line of duty on or after October 1, 1978, consistent with legislation now pending before Congress. This will allow all dependents to be covered under this program.
