An enhancement of \$15,000,000 is requested. Funds will be used to reimburse any Department of Justice organization for (1) the cost incurred in reestablishing the operational capability of an office or facility which has been damaged or destroyed as a result of any domestic or international terrorist incident, and (2) the costs of providing support to counter, investigate or prosecute domestic or international terrorism, including payment of rewards in connection with these activities: Provided that, any Federal agency may be reimbursed for costs of detaining in foreign countries individuals accused of acts of terrorism that violate the laws of the United States.

NOTE:

\$145,000,000 was appropriated in 1999 and was nonrecurred in the Counterterrorism Fund 2000 submission. Funding in 2000 for recurring requirements received in 1999 was requested in the OJP and FBI budget submissions. Funding for 2001 is for the basic traditional mission of the Counterterrorism Fund.
