	A USDA license is required by any person engaging in a regulated activity using covered animals, except when exempted by regulation.
	 Regulated activities include the following: wholesale selling, trading, or negotiating the sale of domestic species retail or wholesale selling, trading, or negotiating the sale of wild or exotic species for purposes other than food, fiber or fur retail or wholesale selling, trading, or negotiating the sale of farm animals for purposes other than food, fiber, fur, agricultural research, or agricultural exhibition selling regulated animals over the allowable limits to research institutions operating an auction selling regulated animals for purposes other than food, fiber research, teaching or testing supplying blood or serum from regulated animals for resale, research, teaching or testing
	 Examples of regulated businesses include, but are not limited to: <i>Pet Wholesalers</i> - selling or trading pets in wholesale channels <i>Pet Breeders</i> - breeding pets for the wholesale trade or selling dogs and cats as breeding stock to other breeders selling wholesale <i>Pet Stores</i> - wholesale selling of pet animals, or wholesale or retail selling of wild animals, exotic animals, non-pet animals, animals for research, or animals for exhibition <i>Laboratory Animal Breeders</i> - breeding regulated animals for the laboratory-animal trade <i>Laboratory Animal Dealers</i> - selling or trading regulated laboratory animals, either directly to research institutions or through other dealers
