Criteria	Regulated animals include, but are not limited to, live or dead:
Exemption	The Secretary of Agriculture has exempted activities involving the following animals from the licensing requirements: • rats of the genus <i>Rattus</i> bred for use in research • mice of the genus <i>Mus</i> bred for use in research • birds • domestic equine species such as: • horses • ponies • miniature horses • mules • donkeys/asses NOTE: This equine species exemption does not include exotic species such as zebras and Przewalski's horses.
