STRUCTURE AND CONSTRUCTION	Facilities must be structurally sound and in good repair. [3.1, 3.25, 3.50, 3.75, 3.101, 3.125]
Criteria	A facility is structurally sound if it: is maintained in good repair (see exception) protects the animal from injury contains the animal restricts entrance of other/unwanted animals
Exception	If the facility has developed, documented, and followed an effective and appropriate <i>maintenance program</i> , a violation may not exist.
Species Specific	Nonhuman Primates Furniture-type fixtures or objects must be: sturdily constructed and safe Marine Mammals RESERVED - Pending approval of negotiated rules.
