Criteria	<ul> <li>Transporting a dog/cat in commerce includes, but is not limited to, delivering a dog/cat to a:</li> <li>carrier or intermediate handler for transport</li> <li>broker or pet store</li> <li>private individual</li> <li>The eight weeks of age, i.e., 56 days, does <b>not</b> include the day of birth. (see chart on page 13.6.2)</li> </ul>
Exceptions	<ul> <li>Dogs and cats less than 8 weeks of age may be transported in commerce:</li> <li>directly to a registered research facility</li> <li>by a private individual who purchased the dog/cat directly from a dealer at the dealer's facility</li> <li>Total Dispersal Sales</li> <li>Dogs and cats less than 8 weeks of age may be transported in commerce in conjunction with a total dispersal sale, i.e., all the dogs and cats on the kennel premises are being sold.</li> <li>The licensee having the sale must:</li> <li>write to the appropriate AC Regional Office prior to the sale for approval to transport underage dogs/cats NOTE: The AC Regional Office will send an approval letter to the licensee.</li> <li>show the approval letter to the auctioneer, if applicable, so it can be advertised and announced that: <ul> <li>this is a total dispersal sale, and</li> <li>licensed/registered persons can transport underage dogs/cats a copy of the approval letter</li> <li>cancel his/her license and return the USDA license certificate to the appropriate AC Regional Office after the sale</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
