PHYSICALLY SEPARATE BUSINESSES	Facilities housing dogs, cats, or nonhuman primates must be physically separated from other businesses on the same premises. [3.1(b), 3.75(b)]
Examples	Other businesses include, but are not limited to: contract pound another dealer on the same property retail sales of other animals boarding kennel grooming parlor veterinary hospital training facility hunting dog dealers/trainers NOTE: Research facilities licensed as dealers are exempt from this requirement.
Criteria	 Examples of physical separation include, but are not limited to: solid wall between the businesses in the same building divider/barrier of sufficient height to denote a clear separation between businesses fence (perimeter) not part of primary enclosure separate entrances into separate animal areas in same building separate buildings restricted access between businesses no common walls
