- an animal must not be exposed to an ambient temperature below $45^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ for a period of more than 45 minutes unless accompanied by an acclimation certificate [3.66(a)(3)]
- ambient temperature is measured at a point not more than 3 feet from an outside wall of the primary enclosure and approximately midway up the side of the enclosure [3.65]
