Chapter V. EN BANC PROCEDURES

5.1. Definitions and General Provisions

- **a. Definitions** For purposes of this chapter:
 - 1. "<u>Full court</u>" means all active judges.
- 2. "En banc court" means that number of judges, greater than three, established by rule of the court, which shall hear and decide cases taken en banc as provided by statute, rule, or in these General Orders.
- recused or disqualified and who entered upon active service before the date of a request for an en banc vote pursuant to GO 5.4.c.1. Notice of recusal or disqualification shall be given to the full court. No senior judge is eligible to vote on whether to take a case en banc. (rev. 1-1-04)
